What to bring to Crew Leader Training



Training work shops may require being outdoors for extended periods of time. Late spring temps range from cool evenings to warm days, so come prepared with clothes to be comfortable in all weather. Orientation Weekend (4 days):

Mandatory Items:

- sleeping bag
- sleeping pad
- rain jacket/pants
- fleece/warm layers
- warm hat and gloves
- head lamp
- notebook and pen/pencil
- 2 water bottles
- personal lunch container
- towel and toiletries and sunblock

Optional Items:

- bug dope
- · camp chair
- camera
- · books and musical instruments
- closed toed shoes for swimming
- sandals
- · coffee mug

Pre-Orientation & Workskills (5 days):

Mandatory Items (plus all of the above):

- day pack
- work boots (leather boots ankle high)
- leather work gloves
- work rain jacket/pants (prepare for mud!)
- work clothes (carhart style pants, jeans, t-shirts, etc)

Optional Items:

- long sleeved work shirt (mandatory for anyone taking chainsaw workshop)
- Eye and Ear Pro (safety glasses, ear plugs)
